In addition, Monoposto plans to repeat our ever popular visit to the Spa Summer Classic at the legendary Spa Francorchamps circuit. Competitors will enjoy 100 minutes of track time, with 2 qualifying sessions and 2 non-championship races spread over 3 days, based in the comfort of the F1 pits.

For the hardy racers, non champ MSVR/Mono events on the Snetterton 200 in March and Brands Hatch Indy in November 'book end' the main season.



# Race days

JMT Mono Championship weekends are "Twin Headers" at two day events, while single day events are run as "Double Headers". A Twin Header means that each day is a separate event, with its own qualifying sessions and races. Double Headers have one qualifying session and two races all on the same day.

At championship events the large Monoposto entry is usually divided by class into two grids, so there is plenty of track action.



Driving Standards: Good racing should be safe, fast and competitive, with drivers respecting their competitors and giving them space when necessary. Monoposto benefits from a regular MSVR Clerk of the Course, who works closely with the JMT Mono Championship Co-ordinator to ensure everyone stays within the rules, and enjoys their racing as safely as possible.

Eligibility: Similarly it's very important that cars comply with the Regulations. Our MSA Eligibility Scrutineer works to ensure a level playing field, and is also able to advise drivers and teams so that they can avoid problems. Each year Monoposto present over 300 trophies at race meetings and a further 50 at the prestigious Annual Awards Ceremony Dinner











# Monoposto in Education - STEM

Monoposto encouragement for engineering students.

Monoposto has always been fortunate to have attracted a number of University and College racing teams ("student teams") for whom the attraction has been that it is a cost effective and relatively open formula, allowing experimentation and modification to the cars, along with a friendly and helpful paddock welcoming newcomers. For 2015 an anonymous benefactor offered a trophy for the most meritorious student team, to be known as the Monoposto STEM Award which reflects the importance in manufacturing of 4 core elements:

Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths.

In 2015 there were three student teams doing battle for the STEM trophy and they all brought enthusiasm, hard work and plenty of biscuit eaters to perform at a very professional level within the championships. <u>University of Wales Trinity St David</u> entered two cars into the Monoposto Championship, <u>University of Wolverhampton</u> entered one car for the Monoposto Championship while <u>Northbrook College</u> entered one car for the Tiedeman Trophy Championship. With outright wins, class wins and trophies between them, the final award came down to an evaluation of results against the competition and the 2015 podium became:

# Tiedeman Trophy Mono Championship

The Founder of the Monoposto Racing Club, Frank Tiedeman, passed away in 2013. Originally launched as a series, the Tiedeman Trophy now enjoys Championship status and provides Monoposto competitors with more low-cost racing opportunities, in addition to the Club's very popular JMT Mono Championship. Operating over a single race day, the format consists of a single grid for all classes with a single qualifying to set the grid for race one, the race two grid is then set by the race 1 result.... which can make for an interesting second grid.

Points in the Championship are scored based on the performance of drivers in their respective classes with a factor for entries in that class. Trophies are awarded for 1-2-3 overall in the races plus a 'Tiedeman Champion of the Day' using the class points formula. Thus the overall 2016 Champion and Champion(s) of the Day could come from any Mono class.
